- Teams are composed of up to 14 players (with a maximum of 2 Liberos)

Registration fee:

- 140 EUR / team (early booking drinks/food voucher of 40 EUR if registration and payment until July 15th)*

** no refund if a team withdraws its participation within 4 weeks before the tournament*

Tournament Format

1st round: 2 groups of 4 -5 teams
Matches played in 2 straight sets until 25 with 2 points difference
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ranking based on points per victory:• Win 2–0 → 3 points for the winning team, 0 for the losing team• Result 1–1 → The sum of all points during the 2 sets will determine the winner ><ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Winner receives 2 points Loser 1 point○ If the teams are still tied, both teams receive 1,5 points
2nd round: Semi-finals (1v2)
The 2 teams ranked 1 st and 2 nd of each pool play a semifinal against the other Pool.
Best of 3 sets to 25 points (2-point difference). If tied: deciding set to 15 points
3rd round: Classification games 5th ranked teams of each Pool in Round 1 will play for the 9th place. <small>(only if we have 10 teams)</small> 4 th ranked teams of each Pool in Round 1 will play for the 7 th place. 3 rd ranked teams of each Pool in Round 1 will play for the 5 th place. Semifinals Losers of round 2 will play for 3 rd place- Semifinals Winners of round 2 will play for 1 st place
Best of 3 sets to 25 points (2-point difference). If tied: deciding set to 15 points

Game Rules

Official FIVB Indoor Rules

Teams may be allocated as referees between their own matches.

Daily Schedule

- Match duration: approx. 50 minutes
- 15 minute break between matches

Catering

- Refreshment stand with food and drinks on site, open to everyone

Equipment & Material

- Jerseys: each team must bring its own uniforms
- Each team must bring it's own balls for warm-up
- Each player should bring a water bottle (eco-responsibility)
