- M11M 2x2 (boys' teams, players born in 2016 or later)
- M11F 2x2 (girls' teams, players born in 2016 or later)
- M13X 3x3 (mixed teams, players born in 2014 or later)

## Categories & Participants

### **Number of teams:**

- M11: 8 boys' teams and 8 girls' teams
- M13: 12 mixed teams

### **Team composition:**

- M11: 2 players on court + up to 2 substitutes
- M13: 3 players on court + up to 3 substitutes

## Tournament Format

<b>1st round: 2 groups of 4 teams (per gender)</b>	<b>1st round: 3 groups of 4 teams</b>
Matches played in 2 straight sets to 15 points	Matches played in 2 straight sets to 25 points
<p>Ranking based on points per victory:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Win 2–0 → 3 points for the winning team, 0 for the losing team</li> <li>• Result 1–1 with one team scoring more total points (e.g., 15–10, 12–15 → total 27–25) → 2 points for the winning team, 1 for the losing team</li> <li>• Result 1–1 with equal total points (e.g., 15–12, 12–15 → total 27–27) → 1.5 points per team.</li> <li>• In case of a tie between 2 teams, ranking will be determined by point difference during matches, then direct comparison.</li> </ul>	

<b>2nd round: Semi-finals (1v2, 3v4)</b>	<b>2nd round: 4 groups of 3 teams</b>

Court size : 4,5 m x 4,5 m	
Net height : 2m	Net height : 2m10
Possibility of a “Canadian pass” on the 2nd contact: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The ball must be passed to a teammate</li><li>• The ball is held and released in one continuous motion</li><li>• The motion must follow the sagittal axis (forward or backward)</li><li>• A player may not move, pivot, or change support while holding the ball</li><li>• A ball held while sliding or diving must be released before the body stabilizes</li></ul>	<b>Triple Ball</b> Volleyball rules Each rally consists of 3 actions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Normal serve (e.g., team A to team B)</li><li>2. The coach of team A enters team B’s court and tosses a ball toward their own team</li><li>3. The coach of T B enters T A’s court and tosses a ball toward their own team</li></ol> <p>All actions result in a point for the team that wins the action. The next serve is awarded to the team that scored the most points across the 3 actions (2–1 or 3–0).</p>
Serve: two-handed underhand toss. Max 3 consecutive serves per player. If the team wins the rally after the 3rd serve, the serve passes to the 2nd player of the same team, and so on.	Serve: one-handed. Max 3 consecutive serves per player. If the team wins the rally after the 3rd serve, the team rotates and the next player serves.
Timeouts: 1 per set (30 seconds)	
Substitutions: max 4 per set	

## **Daily Schedule**

- Match duration: approx. 30 minutes
- 10-minute break between matches

## **Catering**

- Teams may order meals (pasta) for players during registration at 8 EUR per person
- Refreshment stand on site, open to everyone

## **Equipment & Material**

- Jerseys: each team must bring its own uniforms
- Balls provided by the organizers
- Each player should bring a water bottle (eco-responsibility)
